## Verses 1-4

## Verses 5-12

- What is the hope found in verses 5-8?

## Verses 13-16

- Verse 13 is probably the key verse - how do we relate it to today?
- The second woe is found in verse 15 - What is this woe or sorrow?

# ISAIAH 29

## Verses 17-24

- Verses 17-21 again provide hope - How are these blessings both physical and spiritual?
- Verses 22-24, when is this - what has changed?
