- Stimulate one another to love and good deeds (Hebrews 10:24)
- Be hospitable to one another (1 Peter 4:9); and
- Beloved, let us love one another (1 John 4:7)

Therefore, we are called to one another, and ask our Lord for the wisdom and counsel of the Holy Spirit to empower and equip us through Small Group Ministry.
