1) Obey out of Love

Key Verse: If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. (John 14:15)

Questions:

- c) In what areas of your life, you find it hard to obey God? What do you think the reason is?

2) Experience His Presence as you GO

Key Verse: Therefore go And surely, I am with you always (Matthew 28:20)

Questions:

- a) Have you ever experienced God's presence when you have been witnessing or ministering to someone? Share your story.
- **b)** In what ways do you think we should "GO"?

3) Be Courageous

Key Verse: For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes. (Rom 1:16)

Questions:

- a) What fears causes us to become "ashamed" of the Gospel?
- b) Believing what truths can encourage (induce courage to) us?
- c) How could you be courageous but not rude in your witnessing?
