Christ, our example: "Not my will, but your will be done". Luke 22:42

For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for my sake will find it". Matthew 16:24-25

Yes, Jesus just called you a loser. The question is, what kind of loser will you be?

The people of Numbers 13:33 were apparently very large and intimidating. Joshua and Caleb did not dispute this. Goliath's height has been estimated anywhere from 6'6" to 9'6". The average height in bible times may have been around 5'6". Some passages dealing with these giants are found in Joshua 11:22, 14:10-12 and 15:14. You can also read accounts of Israel's encounters with these giant people in this geographic region. 1 Samuel 17 and 2 Samuel 21:15-22.

After bringing consequences on Israel's disobedience and telling them that age 20 and up will not enter the Promised Land, what does He encourage them with in Numbers 15: 1 and 2.

Israel had talked in the past about going back to Egypt: Numbers 11:4-6

God told Israel He would give them The Promised land, but that it would be a process: Exodus 23:29

The Enemies of Your Sanctification: The world, the flesh and the Devil. They are "giants" that you must face as you seek to go forward in your Christian life.

The basis of victory we have through the Cross of Christ over these three enemies because of what He accomplished.

The world – Galatians 6:14, the flesh/old man/old nature – Romans 6:6/Galatians 2:20, the devil/demonic realm (powers and authorities) – Colossians 2:15

Romans 8:37-39 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
